Kitchener University Scholarships

Notice for Scholarships to be awarded in 2017 (Closing date 31st May 2017)

The Council of the Lord Kitchener National Memorial Fund offers for competition up to a maximum of 25 scholarships tenable from October 2017. The value of each scholarship will be £1000 and will be paid to scholars at the beginning of their course. To be eligible a candidate must:

- a) Be a British subject and have served, or be the son or daughter of a parent who has at any time served or is serving on a full time engagement in HM Armed Forces. This includes members and former members of the Territorial Army and other Reserve Forces of the Crown, and their sons and daughters, providing that the former have served an element of full time or permanent service for a minimum consecutive period of three months.
- b) Be admitted as an undergraduate to a university or institution of university rank in the United Kingdom in October 2017 to read for a first degree.
- c) Be over 17 and under 21 years of age on 1st January 2017. Former Service men or women may be considered up to the age of 30.

Applications for a Kitchener University Scholarship will be considered when admittance to a university is dependent upon the results of examinations to be taken in 2017 or earlier.

The preferred method of application is by email. Official application forms, which must be returned completed by the 31st May 2017, are available on the website or may be obtained from the Secretary. Details are at the bottom of the page.

Where possible, applications are to be made as MS Word attachments to an email.

Candidates are judged on academic achievement and potential and account is also taken of evidence of their other interests and activities. Initial selection will take place on receipt of completed application forms and other reports that may be called for. Candidates so selected will be short-listed for interview when final selection will take place.

Short-listed candidates will be called for interview in London normally in July or September.

Interviews cannot be arranged at any other time. Results will be announced in October 2017.
